BASIC INFORMATION

BULLETIN DESCRIPTION

This course will examine a tested method of how to train and encourage Christ-followers to start mentoring and how life on-life mentoring changes lives.

THREE- COURSE OBJECTIVES

- 1. To familiarize students with the fundamental teaching of Jesus Christ regarding salvation, being submitted to Christ and being assured of salvation in Christ in a way that is easily relatable and simple to understand.
- 2. To cultivate the student's ability to personally share the Gospel of Jesus Christ and how to explain it to another person in a mentoring setting that focuses on the relationship rather just than an intellectual teaching.
- 3. To equip students with the tools and confidence to teach others how to have a mentoring relationship.
- 4. To ensure the application of the class content will benefit students to pass it on to others in their ministry and churches.
- 5. To challenge the students to follow the example of Jesus and His Great Commission " ... go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you." Matthew 28:19-20 NIV). Jesus spent the majority of His time during His three years of public ministry, mentoring twelve men He personally chose to be His disciples. The Apostle Paul also encouraged others to mentor as he instructed his mentee Timothy "And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses, entrust

to reliable men who will also be qualified to teach others." (2 Timothy 2:2 NIV)
